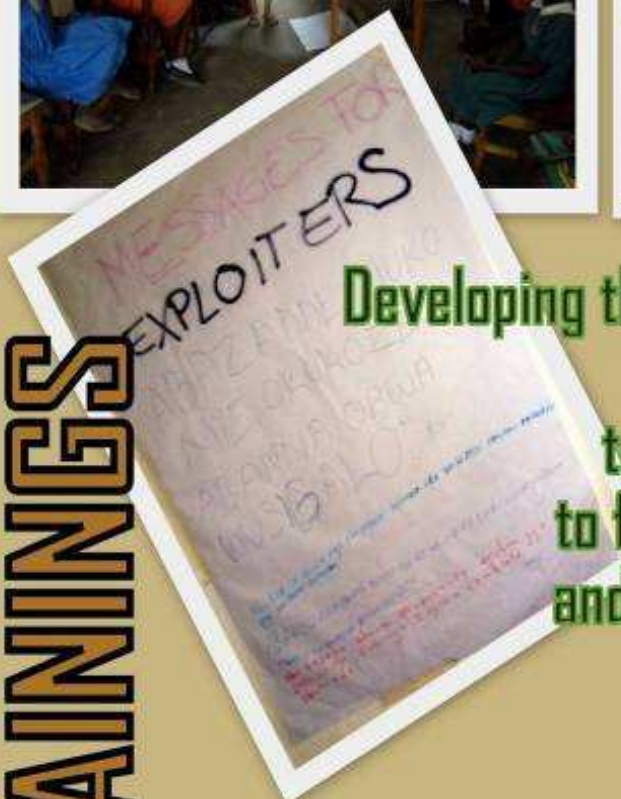

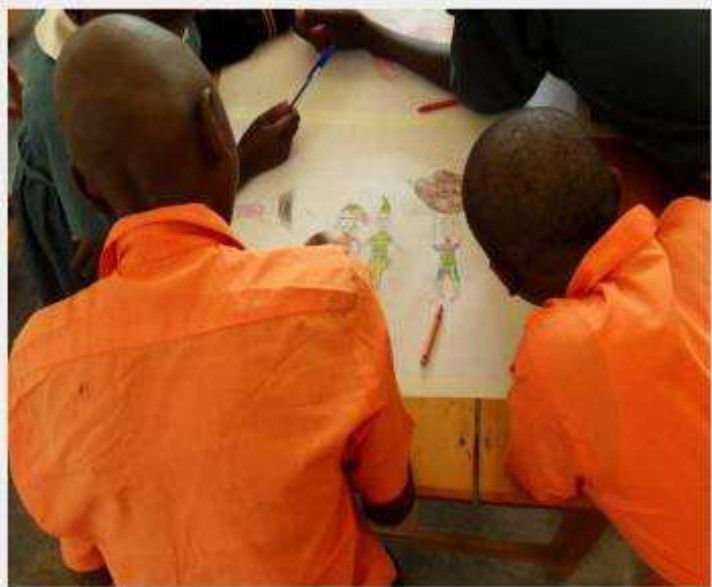
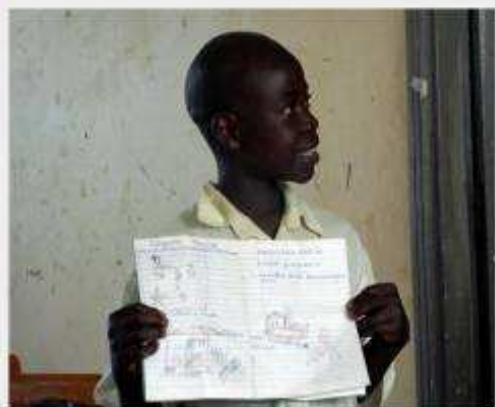

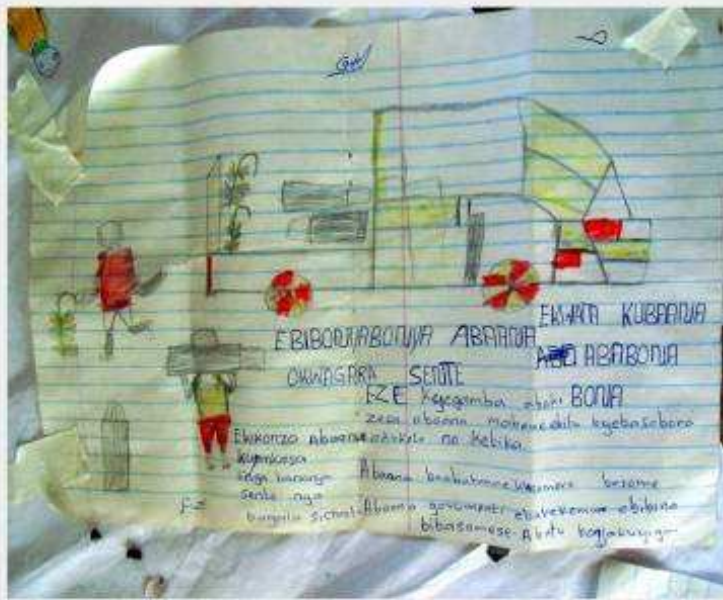

It drew officials from the Rakai District - Administration, Education Department, the Police, subcounty chiefs and the ILO-IPEC implementing agencies and partners.



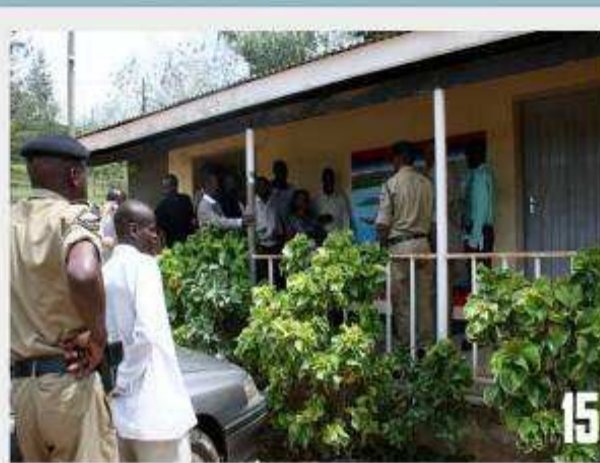

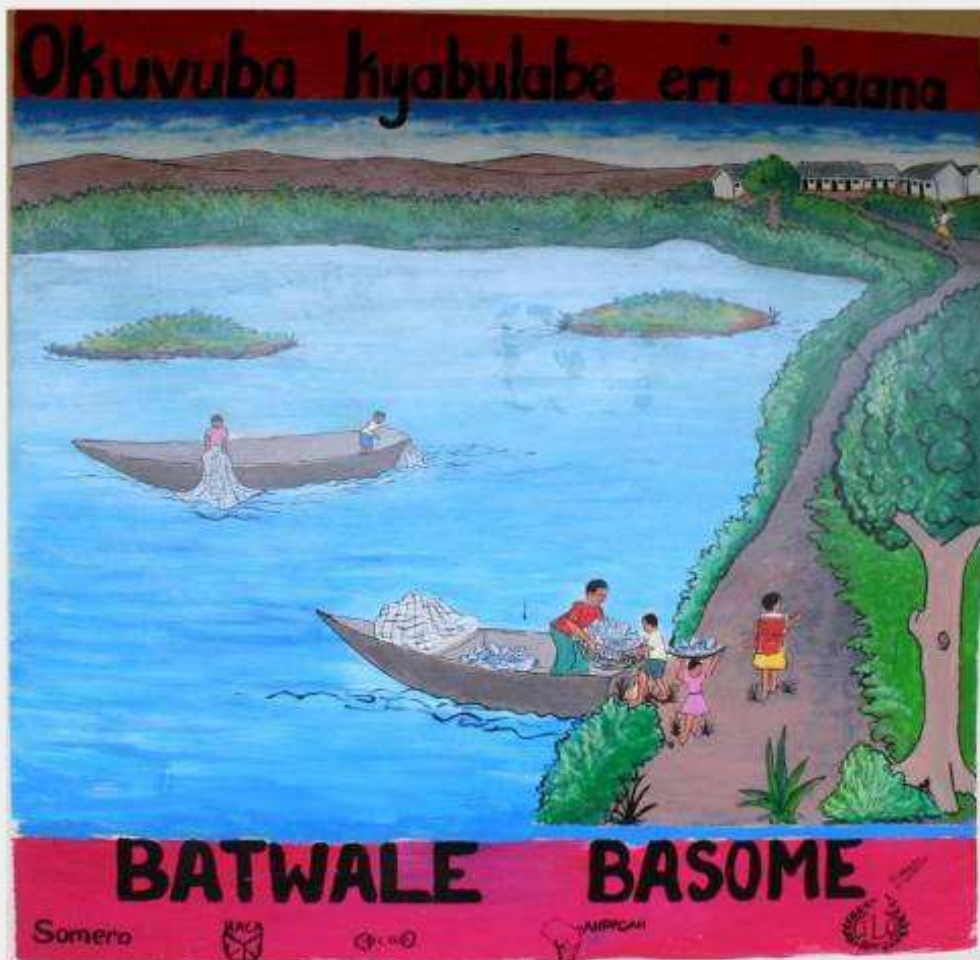

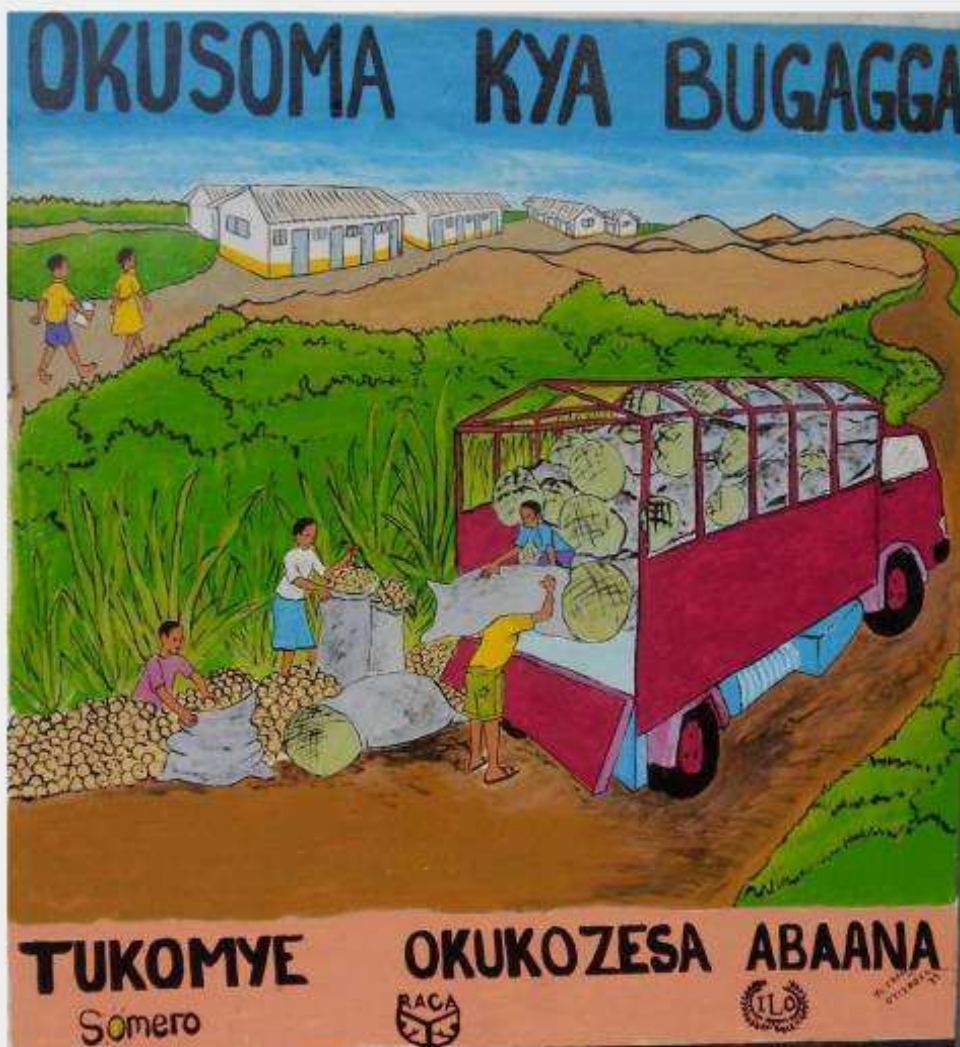
